### Directions to Berea High School

**I-85 SOUTH:** Take I-85 S towards Atlanta to White Horse Road (Hwy 25) exit. Turn right onto White Horse Road and go north about 7 miles. About 1/2 mile past Silver Bay Seafood Restaurant, turn right onto Burdine Drive.

**I-385 NORTH (DOWNTOWN):** Take I-385 N into Downtown Greenville. Go through downtown on College Street and bear to the left onto Hwy 183 (Old Buncombe Road). Take Hwy 183 all the way to White Horse Road (Hwy 25). Turn left onto White Horse Road. Go 1 mile and turn left onto Burdine Dr.

**TRAVELERS REST:** Take Hwy 276 south and turn right onto Hwy 25 (Duncan Road-White Horse Road). Pass Hwy 183 (Farr's Bridge Road). Go 1 mile and turn left onto Burdine Drive.
